We hope it works in accordance with Act of 4 April 2019 on digital accessibility of websites and mobile applications. We are not entirely sure if we are a public body, as all we do we do as an act of personal time allocation.

Compliance status with Act on digital accessibility

This website is partially compliant with Act of 4 April 2019 on digital accessibility of websites and mobile applications operated by public sector bodies due to the non-compliances or the exemptions listed below:

- Titles of sub-pages
 - Sub-pages of the site have undistinguishable titles.

 - There are problems with HTML validation on the site.

 - The site contains justified paragraphs.

 - The language of the site's contents does not match the value of language attribute.
- Accessibility of materials published on the site
 - The site may contain videos without subtitles.
- Forms
 - The site contains form fields with incorrect labels.
